The speaker, Mr. Wilson POOH Wing Hung who is the Manager of United Control Ltd. He is very experienced in conducting flow survey and the usage of various kinds of flowmeters.

The seminar highlighted the equipment as well as the application and procedure of conducting flow survey. Since many of the underground system are built years ago and approach the end of their service life. The efficiency and reliability decline due to the long service life and defects accumulated. In order to assess and evaluate the performance and sustainability of these systems, different kinds of close studies have to be carried out and one of them is flow survey.
