Technical Seminar on “Pipe Rehabilitation by Lining Methods”

14 April 2011

Event Report

The Technical seminar was jointly organized by Hong Kong Institute of Utility Specialists (HKIUS) and Community, Construction Professionals’ Development Centre (CCPDC), funded by the Commerce and Economic Development Bureau of the HKSAR, supported by Hong Kong College of Technology (HKCT) (Causeway Bay Campus), was held successfully on 14 April in HKCT which 80 participants attended the seminar.

With the completion of the guidebooks and pamphlets on the 12 disciplines, a series of technical seminar was being held to disseminate the research result. And seminar on Safety was the eighth of the series.

The Speaker, Mr. Paul Lam Chi Kam is the project manager of BUDA Pipe Rehabilitation Engineering and Co., Ltd. He has over 15 years of experience in building and civil engineering projects. He is involving in various underground and above ground drainage pipes works, underground water supply pipes works by using pressurized and non-pressurized pipelines rehabilitation.

The seminar highlighted different methods available for pipelines rehabilitation works. Mr. Lam introduced the work procedures of pipe rehabilitation work from the planning stage. He emphasized on the planning of the works and illustrated how planning could improve the efficiency of the works. In this seminar, three lining methods were discussed, they were cured-in-pipe, sliplining, and close-fit pipe. The application and installation of these methods were illustrated with examples. Quality control of the works was also mentioned.

The seminar ended by an interactive question-and-answer session. It gave them insights towards the topic. We specially thanked the speaker Mr. Kwong for sharing his valuable experience.
